DAY 1 DEPARTURE (*)

Today we embark on our Journey to the Holy Land. Prepare yourself for a life-changing experience. Get some rest on the flight. Tomorrow you will be walking where Jesus walked! Please arrive at least 3 hours before departure time LY 054(11:00) at EL AL Counter. Arrive at **Ben Gurion Airport 20:20 and be transferred to Hotel Tel Aviv surroundings**

DAY 2 – JOPPA/JAFFA- CAESAREA, MUHRAKA (Mt Carmel), TIBERIAS (*) (D)

Start exploring the "Promised Land," Early morning devotion at the Port of Joppa/Jaffa and reflect on the Biblical references - Many significant events took place at Joppa - where the cedars of Lebanon passed through **The Port**, here on their way to the Temple in Jerusalem; **Jonah, the reluctant prophet**, set sail from Joppa before being swallowed by the great fish; and **Peter raised Tabitha (Dorcas)** from the dead in this city. When an angel of the Lord stood before Cornelius, he instructed him to send men down to Joppa so they could bring the apostle Peter ((Tanners House) back to Caesarea so he could preach to Cornelius and his household We travel along the coast of the Mediterranean Sea to **Caesarea**, where Gentiles first heard the Good News from Peter and were baptized. We'll see the Roman Amphitheatre and aqueduct, and then journey on to **Mt. Carmel**, where Elijah challenged King Ahab and the prophets of Baal. We will see Jezreel Valley and Megiddo, the Armageddon Battlefield, where archaeologists have unearthed 20 levels of civilization. We will have dinner and overnight lodging for the next two nights in the Tiberias area on the Sea of Galilee

Overnight TIBERIAS

Day 3—BANIAS, MT. BEATITUDES, TABGHA , CAPERNAUM, TIBERIAS, BOAT RIDE, MAGDALA (B)(D)

Following breakfast, our morning travels take us to two valuable northern sites. Dan is where the children of Israel fell to the depths of pagan worship Dan, the northernmost city of the Kingdom of Israel. Inscribed stone discovered in Tel Dan is the first place the name David had been found outside of the Bible. The Dan River, is one of the three water sources of the Jordan River. and Caesarea Philippi, the site of Peter's Confession.

CAESAREA PHILIPPI (Banias), one of Israel beautiful nature reserves. According to Matthew, it is the place where Peter expressed his belief that Jesus was the Messiah, and Jesus declared Peter as the rock on which the Church was to be built. Visit **TABGHA** – place of multiplication - In Capernaum we will visit the ruins of an ancient synagogue and Peter's home. **CAPERNAUM** on the northwest shore where Jesus began his preaching career Then we travel on to the site of the possible multiplication of loaves and fishes in



*Bethsaida and the Mount of the Beatitudes overlooking the Sea. **MT. BEATITUDES** where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount, **BOAT RIDE on the Sea of Galilee**, with Time for reflection and prayer. Visit **MAGDALA with the newly founded SYNAGOGE and BEAUTIFUL CHURCH***

*Overnight **TIBERIAS***

Day 4 –NAZARETH, CANA, BEI SH'AN

(B)(D)

*We drive through the area of Cana and Nazareth, where we visit the **Nazareth Village** - Nazareth an Arab city in the Galilee, where Jesus grew to manhood.*

*Visit **Church of Annunciation** where the angel visited Mary, **St Joseph's Carpenter shop**.*

*Continue to the village of **CANA**, the site of the First Miracle for Renewal of Marriage Vows.*

Following the fertile Jordan Valley southward, your guide will point out the agricultural restoration of the "Land of Milk and Honey" and Israel's intricate irrigation development.

*A visit to the excavations at **BEIT SHE'AN** - Beit She'an offers the most extensive archaeological site in Israel, with some of the best-preserved ruins in the Middle East, but its memory will forever be linked to one of the most ghoulish events in the Bible. On nearby Mount Gilboa in 1004 BC, the army of King Saul, Israel's first king, was defeated by the Philistines.*

Check in Hotel at the Dead Sea and overnight

Day 5 –MASSADA, EIN GEDI, QUMRAN, DEAD SEA (B)(D)

*Our day begins with a cable car ride to the mountain top fortress of **MASADA**. Here our guide will treat us to the history of the famous zealot stand. Afterwards we proceed to **EIN GEDI, "Spring of the Goat,"** an oasis on the western shore of the Dead Sea. Because of its warm climate and abundant supply of water, the site developed a reputation for its fragrant plants and date palm groves. This is where King David hid from Saul, and where God defeated the enemies of the Israelites by praise and worship led by King Jehoshaphat.*

*Next, we visit **QUMRAN CAVES** where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. End our day by **floating on the DEAD SEA.***

*Overnight **Bethlehem/JERUSALEM***

Day 6 –JERICHO and SURROUNDINGS (B)(D)

*On our way to **Jericho** we visit the "**0**" Zero Sea level site. **Jericho** - we visit the **FOUNTAIN of ELISHA** and the **RUINS OF THE FALLEN WALLS.***

*Baptism in the Jordan River at **BETABARA**, also known as Qeser El Yehud the Israeli side of Bethany Beyond the Jordan, the original place where Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist, where Elijah and Elisha crossed the Jordan as well as the area where the children of Israel led by Joshua entered the Promised land. Visit the **ISRAEL BIBLE MUSEUM** including the **MODEL OF JERUSALEM.***

*Overnight **BETHLEHEM/JERUSALEM***

DAY 7 A WONDERFUL DAY IN JERUSALEM (B)(D)

ISRAEL FROM SOUTH AFRICA KARELAINE TOURS

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After breakfast drive up to the **MT. OF OLIVES**. Visit the **Church of Dominus Flevit**. Walk the traditional **Palm Sunday Road** to the **GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE** and the **Church of All Nations**. Visit the **GOLDEN GATES** - enter the Old City through the **St. STEPHANS GATE**. Visit the **CHURCH OF ST. ANNE** and the **POOLS OF BETHESDA**. You will walk along the **VIA DOLOROSA** also called the Way of the Cross. There are 14 Stations along the route each commemorating an event along Jesus' route to crucifixion. Walk through colourful bazaars – Enjoy shopping in the Old City. Proceed to the **CARDO** – see the **GOLDEN MENORAH** – dancing on the plains according to Zachariah 3 - Visit the **WESTERN WALL** the Holiest site of the Jewish nation. Night visit to **Ben Yehuda Street**

Overnight **BETHLEHEM/JERUSALEM**

Day 8 – “From the Cradle to the Cross” (B)(*)

After breakfast we visit the **SHEPERDS FIELDS** in Bethlehem – Visit the **NATIVITY CHURCH** (birthplace of Jesus and Shepherds fields) – Pray in the **UPPER ROOM**, Place of the Last Supper. Experience **PETER DE CALLICANTU** where Peter denied Christ, and end the day experiencing Holy communion at the **GARDEN TOMB**. **Airport for departure**

Day 9 Arrival OR Tambo (*)
